He was a fireman for the Cliffside textile mill. Columbus' granddaughter, Agnes, remembers that he always gave the granddaughters a handkerchief for Christmas. He gave the grandsons a mouth harp (harmonica).

In the 1910 Census the Columbus Moore family is listed as living at #4 Church Street, Cliffside. In 1935 the family lived at 24 Green St., in Cliffside.
